Dear Relicensing Stakeholder:

The June aerial survey for wood storks on Lake Murray was performed on June 30, 2005. No wood storks were observed at any of the foraging, roosting, or potential nesting sites. The juvenile great blue herons observed at the Tosity Creek and Silverstreet sites during last months survey seem to have fledged and all nests were vacant at the time of the survey.
